



## Journey Models

Our Journey Models—also known technically as Park Model RVs—are sized at 300 to 400 square feet and built on a custom 15,000–21,000-pound trailer chassis with these standard features:

- Closed-cell polyurethane foam insulation
- 50-amp electrical service with breaker panel
- Dimmable LED lighting
- Natural wood paneling, sheet paneling, and/or wood acoustical panels for noise control
- Andersen “400” or “A” series windows/patio doors
- Metal standing seam or ribbed roofing
- Engineered hardwood or laminate flooring
- RVIA-certified and ANSI 119.5 compliant

Our Daytrip Models—also known as accessory dwelling units, or ADUs—are sized at 80 to 200 square feet, built with the same quality materials as our Journey Models, and serve a variety of purposes, including:

- Ghost kitchens
